



Aboriginal Crew Development Program 2009/2010

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must be:

- Persons of Aboriginal descent (First Nations, Inuit, Metis).
- 18 years of age or older.
- High school or post secondary graduates.
- Currently not attending school.
- A Manitoba resident.
- Legally entitled to work in Manitoba.
- Available for shift work and overtime (days/nights/evenings/weekends.)
- Able to meet the physical requirements of the desired department.
- In possession of a valid Manitoba Driver's License (access to a vehicle may be necessary).

Applicants may be in receipt of EI benefits or Employment and Income Assistance.

Applicants must have:

- Proof of their Aboriginal ancestry.
- Identified a first choice department in which they wish to intern.
- Demonstrated prior and future interest in the industry (i.e. long-term plans, education/workshops, industry experience, volunteer experience.)
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.

Employment Conditions

- This is a full time paid internship for a period of up to 6 weeks (or an average of 250 hours).
- Interns will work on film productions and with film related businesses.
- Interns may work up to a maximum of 12 hours per day
- Interns will be paid at a rate of \$10.00 per hour for up to 8 hours per day, 40 hours per week. Up to 4 hours of overtime may be worked each day (up to 20 hours per week) and be paid at time and a half.
- Interns will also be required to take part in additional program components, including Production Labs and on-line courses.

The Organization

Film Training Manitoba is an industry-driven training organization that identifies and trains individuals for employment in the local film industry. FTM is committed to training that is practical, innovative, and responsive to the demands of the industry in Manitoba.

Application Submissions Must Include:

- Cover Letter
- Completed Application Form
- Resume
- Other related material and certificates (where relevant)

Successful candidates will be selected based on their application, previous experience and an in-person interview. All successful candidates will be required to take an orientation session before their internship placements begin.
