Definitions:

Employed: Persons who are currently doing any work for pay or profit as an employee for someone else.

Not Employed: Persons who are currently not working for pay and are not self-employed.

Self-employed: Persons whose sole source of employment income is self-employment. Self-employed persons are working owners of business (incorporated or non-incorporated), farm or professional practice and self-employed workers who do not own their own business (e.g. commission sales, caregiver, newspaper carrier). A self-employed worker acts as a person in business on his/her own account.

Immigrant/ Refugee: An immigrant is a person who has settled permanently in Canada from another country. This includes those who have obtained a Canadian Passport or who have been granted Citizenship or who have obtained Permanent Resident status. A refugee is a person who was forced to flee from their country and settled in Canada.
